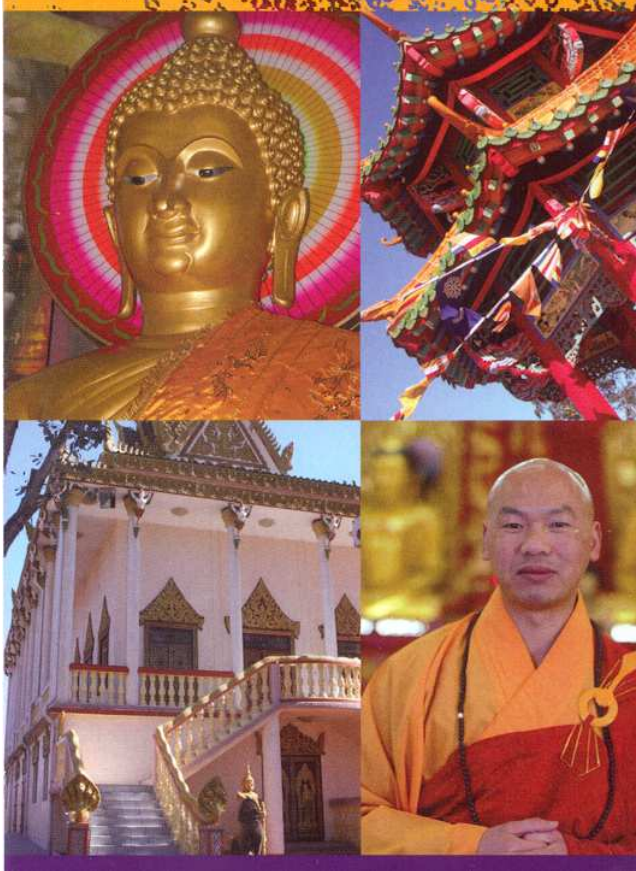

Fairfield City Council provides guided tours of the historical and religious sights of Cabramatta and the surrounding area.

Below is a suggested itinerary.

ARRIVE at Cabramatta Station by train, tour coach or bus where you will be met by your tour guide.

LEARN about the history of Cabramatta at the Whittam Library, where you will view a short film showing the history, religion, culture and art of Cabramatta. The Local Studies Librarian will talk about the history of Cabramatta with time for questions and discussion. Tea and coffee will be served at the Library.

REFLECT at Cabramatta's Indo-Chinese Temple. A guide from the Temple will show you around the Temple and tell you about the beliefs of the worshippers.

DISCOVER Cabramatta's famous shopping and restaurant area, John Street. Visit fabric, tea, herbal and jewellery shops, Asian supermarkets, fish markets, butchers and fruit shops.

ENJOY lunch - choices include Vietnamese, Chinese and Yum Cha restaurants or the more casual Vietnamese cafés.

VISIT the places of worship around Cabramatta by bus. There are several Temples, Mosques and Churches in the area. Your tour guide will discuss options with you when booking your tour. After visiting the places of worship, arrive back at Cabramatta where you can buy quality fresh seafood, meat, fruit and vegetables to take home and enjoy!
