



WATCH OUT AND REPORT FROGBIT

HAVE YOU SEEN THIS ILLEGAL WATER PLANT?

Frogbit (*Limnobium laevigatum*) is a floating freshwater plant from Central and South America.

It can rapidly invade and smother waterways and is a serious biosecurity threat to NSW.







WATCH OUT AND REPORT FROGBIT

LOOK for smooth, rounded, fleshy green leaves up to 4cm across, with sponge-like sections underneath.

CHECK fish ponds, aquariums, fish tanks, water features, dams and local waterways.
