The below information shall be submitted with any application to install a sewage management facility in accordance with clause 26 of the Local Government (General) Regulation 2005.

- (1) Plan the application must be accompanied by a plan, to scale, showing the location of:
- (a) the sewage management facility proposed to be installed or constructed on the premises, and
- (b) any related effluent application areas, and
- (c) any buildings or facilities existing on, and any environmentally sensitive areas of, any land located within 100 metres of the sewage management facility or related effluent application areas, and
- (d) any related drainage lines or pipework (whether natural or constructed).

**Note:** Further to the above, the site plan shall include contours at 0.5M (RL), any existing or proposed dwellings, the location of any existing sewage management facilities and effluent disposal area, the location of any on-site detention basins, any environmentally sensate areas such as creeks or water bodies (including dams and intermittent waterways) and related drainage lines.

- **(2) Specifications -** the application must be accompanied by full specifications of the sewage management facility proposed to be installed or constructed on the premises concerned.
- (3) Site assessment the application must be accompanied by details of the climate, geology, hydrogeology, topography, soil composition and vegetation of any related effluent application areas together with an assessment of the site in the light of those details.
- (4) Statement the application must be accompanied by a statement of:
- (a) the number of persons residing, or probable number of persons to reside, on the premises, and
- (b) such other factors as are relevant to the capacity of the proposed sewage management facility.
- (5) Operation and maintenance the application must be accompanied by details of:
- (a) the operation and maintenance requirements for the proposed sewage management facility, and
- (b) the proposed operation, maintenance and servicing arrangements intended to meet those requirements, and
- (c) the action to be taken in the event of a breakdown in, or other interference with, its operation.

The application shall demonstrate compliance with the following documents:

- a) Fairfield City Council's On-site Sewage Management Strategy Adopted 25 June 2002.
- b) Environment & Health Protection Guidelines On-site Sewage Management for Single Households.
