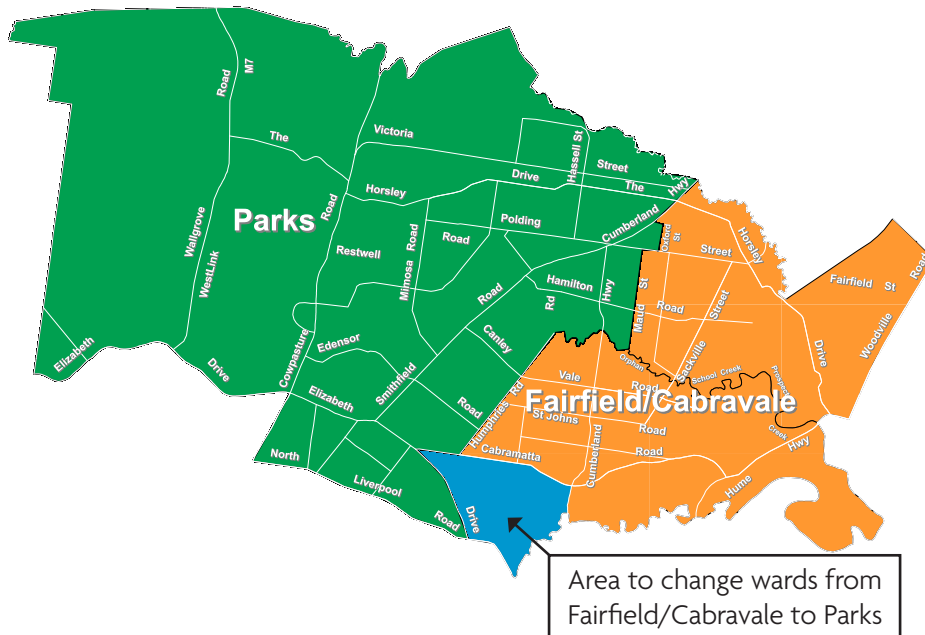


PROPOSED WARD BOUNDARY CHANGES FOR FAIRFIELD CITY COUNCIL

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Local Government Act 1993 requires that wards in any Council must have an even distribution of voters. Therefore at Council's 25 July 2023 Ordinary Council Meeting, it was resolved that an adjustment be made to the boundaries of the Parks and Fairfield/Cabravale wards, and that the community be consulted on this matter, in accordance with Section 210A of the Act. The adjustment proposes moving residents in a small part of the Fairfield/Cabravale Ward to the Parks Ward to ensure voter numbers remain relatively equal between the wards. A copy of the report to Council and the Council resolution can be viewed on the Council website.

Below is a ward boundary map highlighting the proposed boundary adjustment.



The ward boundary map will be on public exhibition from Friday 28 July to Monday 28 August. You can view the map:
