Council has the right to refuse entry if the conditions are not met

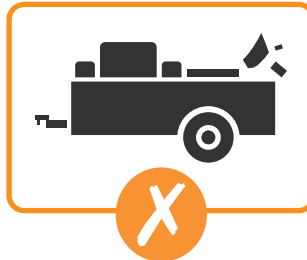
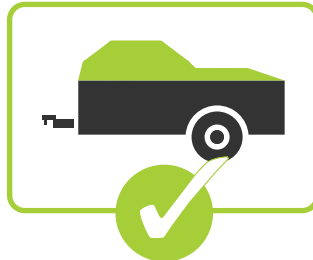
- Please remain in your vehicle on arrival

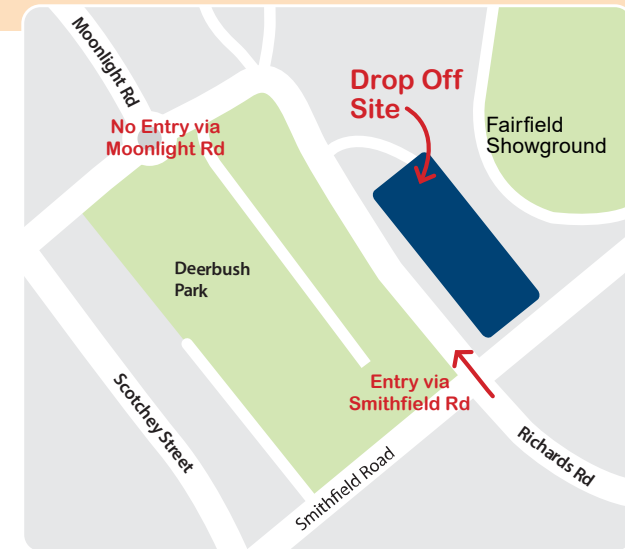

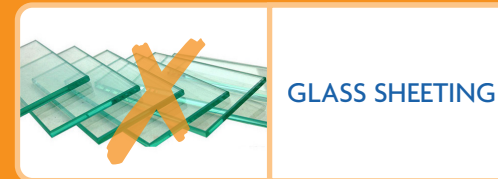
